Dear Parent / Guardian,

I want to take this opportunity to thank you for accepting a place for your son/daughter in Coláiste Dún Iascaigh for the next academic year 2025/2026. I hope your son/daughter is enjoying their final year in primary school before they begin their post primary school journey. To help in this transition the following steps have been put in place over the next few months to support a smooth transition into first year.

January/ February: Primary School Visits During January and February

Ms. Burke (ASD lead), Ms. Green (AEN Coordinator) and Ms. Tarrant (Deputy Principal) will be meeting with all primary schools. The purpose of these visits is to gather information that will support the transition of your child into the Coláiste. I would like to thank all our feeder primary school for facilitating this.

25th February: School Information Night

An important School Information Night for parents/guardians and our incoming first years will be held on the 25th February in the school. The sitting should last approximately 50 minutes. Your son/daughter is also invited to attend. You will get Information on

- The Junior Cycle curriculum and CBA's (class based assessments)
- Subject choice
- Information on extra-curricular activities
- Day to day school schedule
- School policies
- Transition steps and Induction week
- Student supports
- VSware student management system
- and any other questions you may have for us

An electronic form (link on a text message) will issue to you prior to this meeting which will give you an opportunity to ask any questions which you would like covered at the meeting.

3rd – 7th March: One to One meetings:

During the week commencing the 3rd March there will be one to one meetings with parent/ guardians and your son/daughter in the school. These meetings are informal which we have found very beneficial over the previous years. Again it's all part of helping your son/daughter to settle into the school, get a feel for the environment, get to meet some people from the school and an opportunity to ask any questions you may have. Shortly before this meeting a form will be issued to your phone where a series of questions are asked. These questions will vary from interests/ hobbies, whether they have siblings in the school, any medical issues we need to know about and a series of other pieces of information that is necessary for us at this particular stage. Your co-operation in completing this form would be very much appreciated.

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24th – 28th March: CAT (Cognitive Ability Testing) in Coláiste Dún Iacaigh

The next step of the transition process happens between 24th and the 28th March when all of our incoming first years will come to the Colaiste for CAT testing. It will give the incoming first years another opportunity to visit the school. A report of the results will be posted home to the parents/guardians following the testing which can aid with subject selection.

31st March / 11th April: A Subject Option Form

An electronic form will be issued on the 31st March with a deadline of 11th April that will allow parents / guardians to complete your son/daughters subject choice.

May: Additional visits to the school

Additional visits for some of incoming first years take place during the month of May.

June: Information letter / Educational Passports

A letter will be issued to all parents outlining start dates for the 2025/2026 academic year, school calendar 2025/2026 and relevant information. Educational passports will also be transferred from the primary school to the Colaiste outlining extra information regarding your son/daughter.
